## MATERIAL LIST

THREAD: VEEVUS 14/0 BLACK

HOOK: DOHIKU 301 DRY #12-16 OR PREFERRED DRY FLY HOOK

TAIL: HAIRS FROM A HARE'S MASK

**BODY: NATURAL HARE'S EAR + DUBBING** WING CASE: 1-3 CDC PLUMES FOLDED

THORAX: HARE'S EAR DUBBING OR CDC DUBBED

WINGS: REMAINING CDC FIBRES FOLDED BACK AND DIVIDED

WITH THREAD

SIGHTER (OPTIONAL): GLO BRITE FLOSS NO. 5

NOTES: This CDC & hare's ear fly is a great candidate to cover just ABOUT ANY MAYFLY HATCH YOU FIND YOURSELF IN.

To tie the wing: Tie 1-3 cdc plumes in, tips back, about halfway up the STEM, TRIM THE BUTTS. DUB YOUR THORAX OVER THE BUTTS, FOLD ALL CDC BACK OVER TOWARD THE EYE. PULL AS MANY LOOSE CDC FIBRES BACK AND HOLD THEM BACK WITH THREAD, CUT THE REMAINING STEMS OUT. SPLIT THE WINGS WITH YOUR THREAD AND ADD DOUBLED OVER PIECE OF GLO BRITE FOR A SIGHTER.
